The Gator Girl Shootout was started at Lexington Country Club in the 2010-2011 season and has continued every year except for the 2019-2020 season when the COVID pandemic made it necessary to cancel the event.

This event is played by the 10 players who have accumulated the most points during the LLGA season. They play a 9-hole "shootout". All 10 players tee off on the first hole. One player is eliminated on each hole until the winner is determined. Handicap strokes are given.

Everyone is invited and encouraged to come and follow along with the players to see who the next "Gator Girl" will be.

The points are awarded as follows: *

5 Points for playing any Ladies Day Event

3 Extra Points for 1st Place

2 Extra Points for 2nd Place

1 Extra Point for 3rd Place

#1 Point for Low Net (When applicable)

#1 Point for Low Gross (When applicable

*When scrambles are played, all participants receive 5 points, there are no points given for the three top places.

#Golf Genius will break all ties with a scorecard playoff as identified according to the PGA golf rules. No one can take gross and net both (gross tops net). Top points that can be accumulated by any player for a week is (9). E.G., 5 Points for playing, 3 Points for 1st Place, 1 Point for either Gross of Net score.

Each week the top 10 will be posted on the LLGA website, on Facebook and posted on the bulletin board outside the Pro Shop. The report with the running totals will also be posted on the website each week and once a month put on the bulletin board in the Ladies Locker Room.
